RING 1 NOT BEFORE 12.30

YOUNG HANDLERS - Open to any breed 4 yrs & over, mares and geldings only (excludes colts and stallions)

Hard hats must be worn

Class 15 - Under 10 years (may be accompanied by an adult)

Class 16 - 10 to 16 years

Championship - 1st & 2nd from classes 15 & 16 eligible

LEAD REIN & FIRST RIDDEN

Judge: Natalie Fraser

Class 17 - Lead Rein mare or gelding 4yrs & over height not to exceed 122cm. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 18 - First Ridden mare or gelding 4yrs & over height not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Suitable snaffle bridles only.

Mini Ridden Championship - 1st & 2nd from Classes 17 - 18 eligible

NOVICE RIDDEN - (classes may be split if sufficient entries) **Not to have won 1st place in an open ridden class. Suitable snaffle bridles only**

N.B Stallions may not be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for small breeds or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for large breeds

RING 2 - STARTS 9AM

IN HAND CLASSES

Open to registered/unregistered stallion, mare or gelding. *N.B In the interest of safety all stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and be led by a handler that has attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.*

Class 32 - SHP/Show Pony open to any age 148 cm & under

Class 33 - Arab/Partbred Arab - open to any age/height

Class 34 - Veteran - open to any type 15 yrs plus

In Hand Championship 1st & 2nd from classes 27 - 34 eligible. Ch & Res. eligible for Supreme In Hand Championship

RIDDEN CLASSES - Not before 12.30

Open to registered/unregistered horses/ponies 4yrs old & over - stallion, mare or gelding. *N.B Stallions must display a bridle disc & may not be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for small breeds/types or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for large breeds/types.*

THIS SHOW IS RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH NSWPCA, WPCS & SPSBS RULES

1. HORSE RIDING IS A DANGEROUS SPORT AND YOU ENTER/ATTEND AT YOUR OWN RISK

2. The committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
3. All entries must be registered or eligible for registration in the Welsh Stud Book or appropriate Breed Society. Registered numbers must be stated, including the numbers of the sire and dam, before the entry is accepted.
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry. Entries must be made on the official NSWPCA entry form & include the correct fee to be accepted. Cheques that are not honoured by the bank may result in suspension of membership or refusal of future entries to Association events.
5. Entry fees are not refundable under any circumstances
6. Exhibitors must not enter an animal in any Show when that animal will be judged by a person who has or has had a financial interest in that particular exhibit.
7. Exhibitors are requested to note the timetable, animals must be forward in time. Classes will not be held if exhibitors have entered in more than one class
8. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the Committee take no responsibility if a clash occurs. Latecomers will ONLY be admitted to the ring at the discretion of the Judge and the Head Steward
9. Stallions and Colts: A stallion is accepted as such when 4 years of age. Colts may be licensed from 1st January of their second year. In the interest of safety all stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler that has attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Stallions may not be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for Welsh Sections A & B or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for Welsh Sections C & D.
10. **The Judge's decision is final.**
11. The Committee or any of its assistants or stewards will not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or leaving the same under any circumstances.
12. All animals must be sound. If in the opinion of the Judge, an animal is considered to be unsound, the exhibitor will be given the option of withdrawing the exhibit from the class or asking that the official veterinary surgeon examine the animal. If no veterinary surgeon is available, the Judge's decision is final.
13. Any animal found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease is to be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
14. Objections MUST be made in writing within thirty minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Show Secretary together with the sum of £25. Objections will be referred to the Complaints Committee which will return the £25 if the objection is upheld.
15. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding hats to current safety standards must be worn by riders at all times.
16. The safety of all children showing animals is the full responsibility of their parent or guardian.
17. Trophies are perpetual and the winner of any trophy or cup is responsible for its safe return to the Show Secretary in time for the following year's show. All trophies remain the property of the Association.
18. The Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge at short notice if conditions warrant.
19. Bad language and/or abusive behaviour towards people or animals will not be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the showground.
20. The use of any artificial aid (e.g. plastic bags, excessive use of whips, drinks cans etc.) to excite an animal being shown is not acceptable and should not be used at any NSWPCA show.

Please park with consideration and do not muck out horseboxes/trailers onto the car park. Please pick up your horses droppings and take your rubbish home. Children must be supervised at all times. Dogs to be kept on leads and owners must clear up after them. Thank you
