NPS SCOTLAND RULES 2018

This show is a qualifier for the NPS Scotland Finals held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 24th August 2018.

These rules apply to each qualifying class. Specifics to each class is printed within that section of the schedule.

1. Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final. Ponies that take a second qualifier for the same section will not be allowed to enter the final.
 2. All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred, X registered ponies, ponies in the appendices of their main stud book and Eriskays are not eligible.
 3. Qualification in the M&M In Hand Section may go to 3rd in the Championship.
 4. All others may go to no lower than 4th place.
 5. **A Judge is not obliged to award an NPS Scotland Finals qualification if he/she feels that the pony is not of a sufficient standard**
 6. **Novice Ponies**
 7. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:
 - a. Won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
 - b. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
 - c. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
 - d. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Kilmannan or Picton Final.
- Rider any age, except stallions (see rules).
Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.
A minimum of 6 ponies must be stripped in qualifying rounds. All ponies will be stripped in the Final.
8. **Closing Dates for Entries:**
Competitors qualifying at Shows held before Monday 4th June 2018 must send their qualifying cards and entries in by Thursday 28th June 2018.
Shows after 5th June 2018 adhere to a closing date of 1st August 2018 and Late Entries will NOT be accepted. Competitors that qualify at late shows after the 1st August 2018 are required to email the secretary and send in the qualifying cards within 3 days of the show.
 9. **Cavesson nosebands** are the only nosebands permitted in flat ridden classes.
 10. Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card duly signed by the Judge at the time of qualifying with your entry form.
 11. The **OWNER** must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Finals.
 12. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class.
 13. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 12 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.
 14. A child must have attained their 12th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year to either strip or lunge a pony at an NPS show, except for stallions where age will same as in the Rule Book to ride a stallion.
 15. Handlers of stallions or colts must be 14 years old or over.
 16. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets the current standards.
 17. The Final will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 24th August 2018.

THIS SHOW IS RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH NSWPCA, WPCS, NPS, SPSBS & TSR RULES

1. Horse riding is a dangerous sport and you participate at your own risk

2. The committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
3. All entries must be registered or eligible for registration in the Welsh Stud Book or appropriate Breed Society. Registration Numbers, where applicable, must be stated, including the numbers of the sire and dam, before an entry is accepted.
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry. Entries must include the correct fee to be accepted. Cheques that are not honoured by the bank may result in suspension of membership or refusal of future entries to Association events.
5. **Entry fees are non refundable under any circumstances**
6. Exhibitors must not enter an animal in any show/class when that animal will be judged by a person who has or has had a financial interest in that particular exhibit.
7. Exhibitors are requested to note the timetable, animals must be forward in time. Classes will not be held if exhibitors are entered in more than one class
8. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the Committee take no responsibility if a clash occurs. Latecomers will only be admitted to the ring at the discretion of the Judge and the Head Steward
9. Stallions and Colts: A stallion is accepted as such when 4 years of age. Colts may be licensed from 1st January of their second year. In the interest of safety all stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler that has attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Stallions may not be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for Welsh Sections A & B or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for Welsh Sections C & D.

10. The Judge's decision is final.

11. The Committee or any of its assistants or stewards will not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or leaving the same under any circumstances.
12. All animals must be sound. If in the opinion of the Judge, an animal is considered to be unsound, the exhibitor will be given the option of withdrawing the exhibit from the class or asking that the official veterinary surgeon examine the animal. If no veterinary surgeon is available, the Judge's decision is final.
13. Animals suffering from a contagious or infectious disease should not be brought to the Showground. Any animal found to be suffering must be removed immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
14. Objections **MUST** be made in writing within thirty minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Show Secretary together with the sum of £25. Objections will be referred to the Complaints Committee which will return the £25 if the objection is upheld.
15. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding hats to current safety standards must be worn by riders at all times.
16. The safety of all children showing animals or not is the full responsibility of their parent or guardian.
17. Trophies are perpetual and the winner of any trophy or cup is responsible for its safe return to the Show Secretary in time for the following year's show. All trophies remain the property of the Association and must be signed for.
18. The Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge at short notice if conditions warrant.
19. Bad language and/or abusive behaviour towards people or animals will not be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the showground with any entry fees being forfeited
20. The use of any artificial aid (e.g. plastic bags, excessive use of whips, drinks cans etc.) to excite an animal being shown is not acceptable and should not be used at any NSWPCA show.
