

### **The 2019 Caledonian Showing Championships**



The Caledonian Showing Championships are now well established in the showing calendar and will once again give 2019 competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. Evening Performances, loads of bling and razzmatazz .... everything an end of season Championship should have! This year's show will be held at Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 12th & 13th October 2019.

This Show is a qualifier and every horse and pony placed 1st and 2nd in all In Hand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website <a href="https://www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com">www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com</a> where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information.

N.B Stallions must display a bridle disc & may not be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for small breeds or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for large breeds

### THIS SHOW IS RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH NSWPCA, WPCS & SPSBS RULES

### 1.HORSES & PONIES CAN BE UNPREDICTABLE & RIDING IS A DANGEROUS SPORT. YOU ENTER/ATTEND THE SHOW AT YOUR OWN RISK

- 2. The committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
- 3. Entries for Welsh & Welsh Partbred must be registered or eligible for registration in the Welsh Stud Book. Entries for Shetland & M&M classes must be registered or eligible for registration with the appropriate Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated, including the numbers of the sire and dam before the entry is accepted. Welsh Partbred entries must quote WPCS registration number
- **4.** The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry.
- 5. Entries must be made on the official NSWPCA entry form & include the correct fee to be accepted.
- 6. NSWPCA Members must state their membership number on the entry form to enter at the reduced entry fee
- 7. Cheques that are not honoured by the bank may result in suspension of membership or refusal of future entries to Association events.
- 8. Entry fees are not refundable under any circumstances
- **9.** Exhibitors must not enter an animal in any Show when that animal will be judged by a person who has or has had a financial interest in that particular exhibit.
- 10. Exhibitors are requested to note the timetable, animals must be forward in time. Classes will not be held.
- **11.** Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the Committee take no responsibility if a clash occurs. Latecomers will ONLY be admitted to the ring at the discretion of the Judge and/or the Head Steward
- 12. Stallions and Colts: A stallion is accepted as such when 4 years of age. Colts may be licensed from 1st January of their second year. In the interest of safety all stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler that has attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Stallions may not be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for Welsh Sections A & B or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for Welsh Sections C & D.
- 13. The Judge's decision is final.
- **14.** The Committee or any of its assistants or stewards will not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or leaving the same under any circumstances.
- **15.** If in the opinion of the Judge, an animal is considered to be unsound or **obese**, the exhibitor will be given the option of withdrawing the exhibit from the class or asking that the official veterinary surgeon examine the animal. If no veterinary surgeon is available, the Judge's decision is final.
- **16.** Any animal suffering from a contagious or infectious disease must not be brought to the showground. Any animal on the showground found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease must be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee
- **17.** Objections MUST be made in writing within thirty minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Show Secretary together with the sum of £25. Objections will be referred to the Complaints Committee which will return the £25 if the objection is upheld.
- 18. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding hats to current safety standards must be worn by riders at all times.
- 19. The safety of all children attending or showing animals is the full responsibility of their parent or guardian.
- **20.** Trophies are perpetual and the winner of any trophy or cup is responsible for its safe return to the Trophy Secretary in time for the following year's show or as instructed. All trophies must be signed for and remain the property of the Association.
- 21. The Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge at short notice if conditions warrant.
- **22.** Bad language and/or abusive behaviour towards people or animals will not be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the showground.
- **23.** The use of any artificial aid (e.g. plastic bags, excessive use of whips, drinks cans etc.) to excite an animal being shown is not acceptable and should not be used at any NSWPCA show.

Please park with consideration & do not muck out horseboxes/trailers onto the car park. Please pick up your horses droppings & take your rubbish home. Children should be supervised at all times. Dogs to be kept on leads & owners must clear up after them. Thank you
