JUDGE - K. TEDCASTLE

YOUNG HANDLERS - Open to any breed 4 yrs & over, mares & geldings only.

Hard hats must be worn

Class 1 - Under 10 years (may be accompanied by an adult)

LEAD REIN & FIRST RIDDEN - JUDGE - K. ROSS

Class 3 - Lead Rein. Mare or gelding any breed 4 years old and over height not to exceed 121.9cm (12hh) Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies to be shown in a snaffle bridle. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband only. To be led by an attendant

Class 4 - First Ridden. Mare or gelding any breed 4 years and over height not exceeding 128cm (12.2 hh). Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies to be shown in any suitable bridle. Ponies will not be cantered except in their individual show.

ALL RIDDEN CLASSES MAY BE SPLIT/AMALGAMATED DEPENDING ON ENTRIES

Stallions may NOT be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for small breeds or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for large breeds

NOVICE RIDDEN - Not to have won an Open class by 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only

NSWPCA SHOWS ARE RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH WPCS RULES IN ADDITION TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. The committee reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or split classes according to entries
2. Where applicable entries must be registered or eligible for registration in the Welsh Stud Book or with the appropriate Breed Society.
3. If applicable, registered numbers must be stated including the numbers of the sire and dam before the entry is accepted. Incomplete entries forms will not be accepted.
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry. Entries must include the correct fee to be accepted. Cheques that are not honoured by the bank may result in suspension of membership and/or refusal of future entries to the Association events.
5. Exhibitors must not enter an animal in any class when that animal will be judged by a person who has or has had a financial interest in that particular exhibit. A rider or handler must not compete in a class judged by a person for whom he/she has ridden or produced in hand during the previous and current showing season.
6. **ENTRY FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES**
7. Exhibitors should note that the timetable is a guide only and may be subject to change. Competitors are responsible for ensuring animals are forward in time. Classes will not be held if exhibitors are entered in classes that clash.
8. Latecomers will ONLY be admitted to the ring at the discretion of the Judge on production of a late entry slip which must be given to the Steward
9. Exhibitors displaying incorrect back numbers will be refused entry to classes
10. Stallions and Colts: A stallion is accepted as such when 4 years of age. Colts may be licensed from 1st January of their second year. In the interest of safety all stallions and colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler that has attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Stallions may not be ridden by a Junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year for small breeds or their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year for large breeds.
11. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL**
12. The Show Committee or any of its assistants or stewards will not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought to the Showground or leaving the same.
13. If an animal entered in a class is, in the opinion of the judge unsound, the judge shall, at his/her discretion, require the exhibitor to withdraw the animal from that class or place it at the end of the line. The judge's decision in this matter is final.
14. Any animal found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease is to be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
14. Objections MUST be made in writing within thirty minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Show Secretary together with the sum of £25. Objections will be referred to the Complaints Committee which will return the £25 if the objection is upheld.
16. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding hats to current safety standards must be worn by riders at all times.
17. Children must be supervised at all times and their safety, whether showing or attending the show, is the full responsibility of their parent or guardian.
18. Trophies are perpetual and the winner of any trophy or cup is responsible for its safekeeping and return to the Show Secretary in accordance with NSWPCA terms & conditions. All trophies MUST be signed for.
19. The Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge at short notice if conditions warrant.
20. Abusive/aggressive behaviour/language towards people or animals will not be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the showground
21. The use of any artificial aid (e.g. plastic bags, drink cans, excessive use of the whip etc.) to excite the animal being shown is not acceptable and is not permitted at N.S.W.P.C.A. shows.
22. **Trimming:** It is acceptable for Welsh breeds to be trimmed of hair under the jaw line, round the muzzle and protruding from the ears. All other breeds should be trimmed in accordance with their breed standard
23. **Clipping:** Animals four years old or over, may be clipped for winter activities. Legs must not be clipped. Youngstock must *not* be body clipped
24. If, in the judge's opinion, an unruly animal is likely to cause an accident the judge is empowered to ask for it to be removed from the ring
